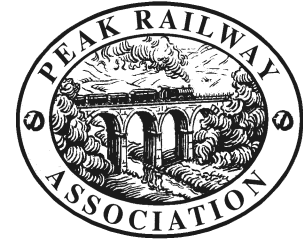

The aim of the Peak Railway Association is to provide help, support and advice to Peak Rail plc, this includes raising funds for specific projects, recruiting new members and volunteers, and helping to operate the existing railway from Matlock to Rowsley. The Association is managed by its own Board of Directors including representatives from Peak Rail plc, who are elected by members at an Annual General Meeting. At the AGM every member is entitled to attend and vote and also raise any questions they may have. Members are also able to become volunteers on the railway.

The subscriptions and donations received from members are used to finance the activities of the Association, such as the costs of producing The Peak Express magazine and fund specific projects around the railway. Items funded include the refurbishment of the ex Bamford signal box and its relocation to Rowsley. Repainting and reupholstering of carriages, new digital telephone exchanges at Darley Dale and Rowsley, sleepers for the main line, track components for Darley Dale level crossing, a building for the storage of the archive collection and the restoration of an LMS Brakevan.

As a member of the Association you will currently receive the following benefits:-

2. Up to four days free travel per year, with a 50% discount on all subsequent travel, on Peak Rail trains on all operating days except for Special Events (as set out in our annual timetable).
